ORDER

Government of India, as per the notification read above, have prescribed the composition and terms of reference of State Level Committee on Standardization to be constituted for promoting the use of Indian Standards as a means to create a robust quality ecosystem in the country and protect the interest of the consumers by ensuring active involvement of the States in the formulation and use of Standards.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to constitute the State Level Committee on Standardization Kerala with the following composition and Terms of Reference:

B. Terms of Reference of the Committee:

- i. Identifying areas for the formulation of new Indian Standards.
- ii. Identifying products, processes and systems for enforcing compliance with Indian Standards.
- iii. Measures for effective implementation of Quality control Orders (QCOs) issued by Government of India.
- iv. Measures for awareness generation among consumers regarding Standards.
- v. Any other activity to create a robust quality ecosystem in the State.

C. The term of engagement of non-government bodies is three years, however, they are eligible for re-nomination.

D. The Committee shall meet at least twice a year, and as many more times, as deemed fit by the Chairperson.
